- Windows 7 and higher
- A computer that supports Thunderbolt 2 technology or first generation Thunderbolt technology. To take advantage of the higher performance offered by Thunderbolt 2 technology, your computer must have a Thunderbolt 2 technology port (see <u>LaCie 5big Thunderbolt 2</u>: <u>Advanced Storage Technology</u>).
