

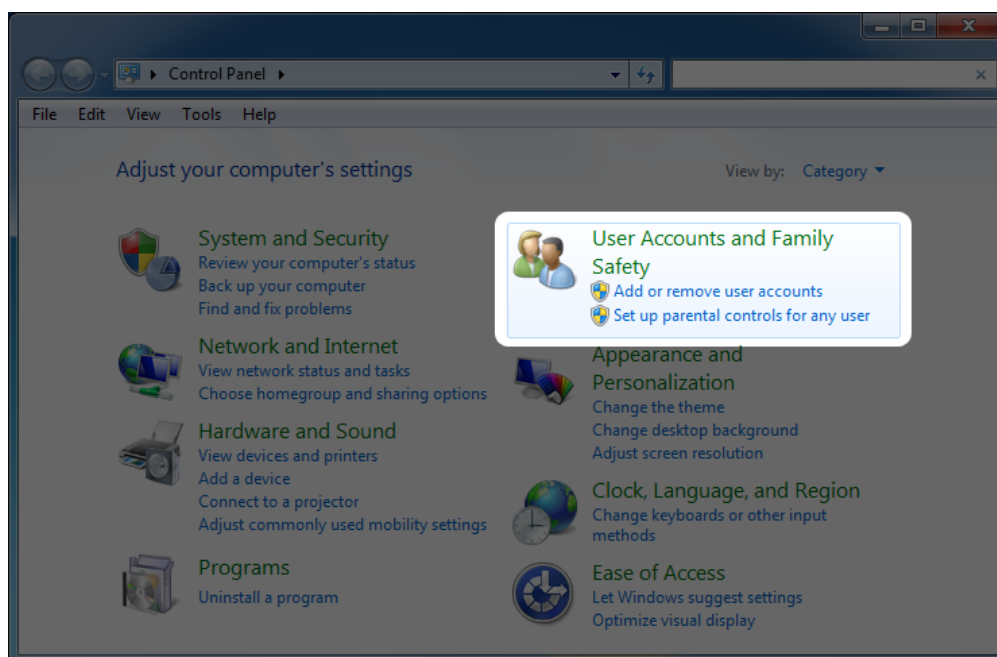
ASSIGNING AN ADMINISTRATOR PASSWORD

MAC USERS

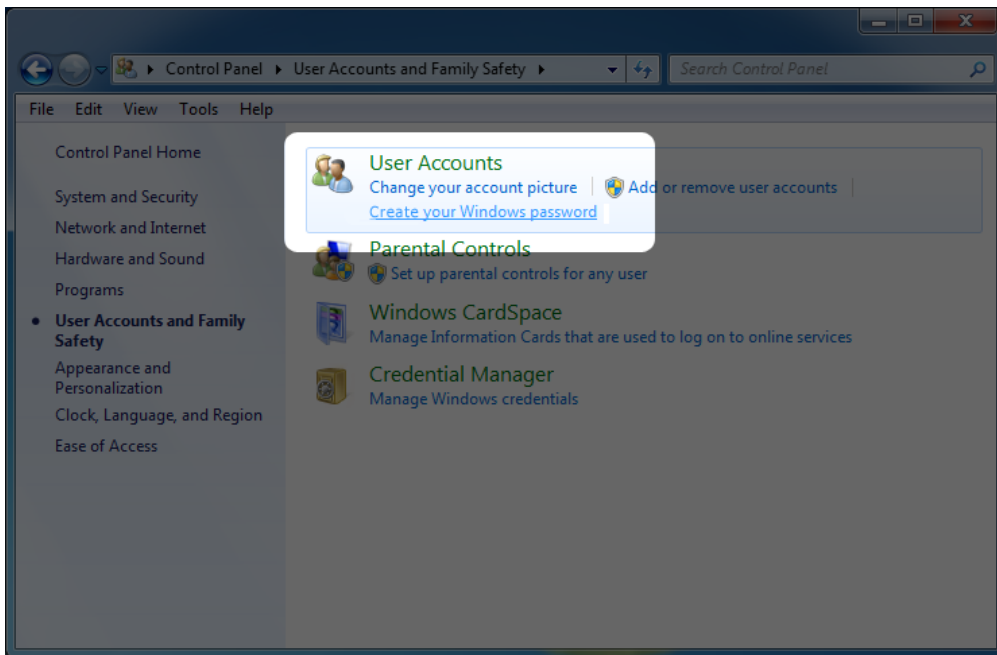

WINDOWS 7 AND VISTA USERS

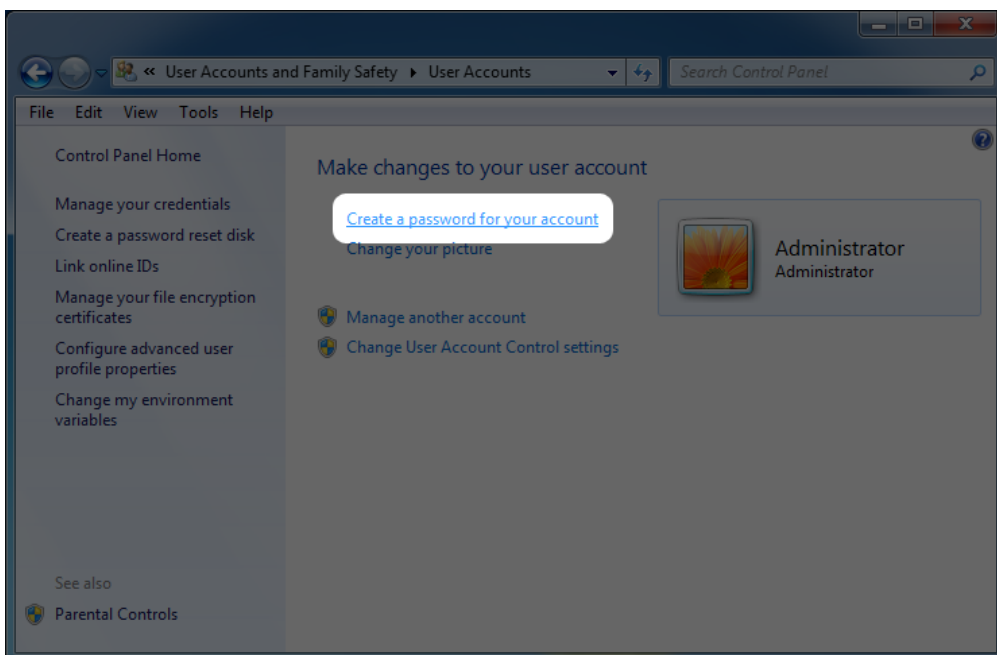
1. Navigate to **Start > Control Panel**.
2. Select **User Accounts and Family Safety**.



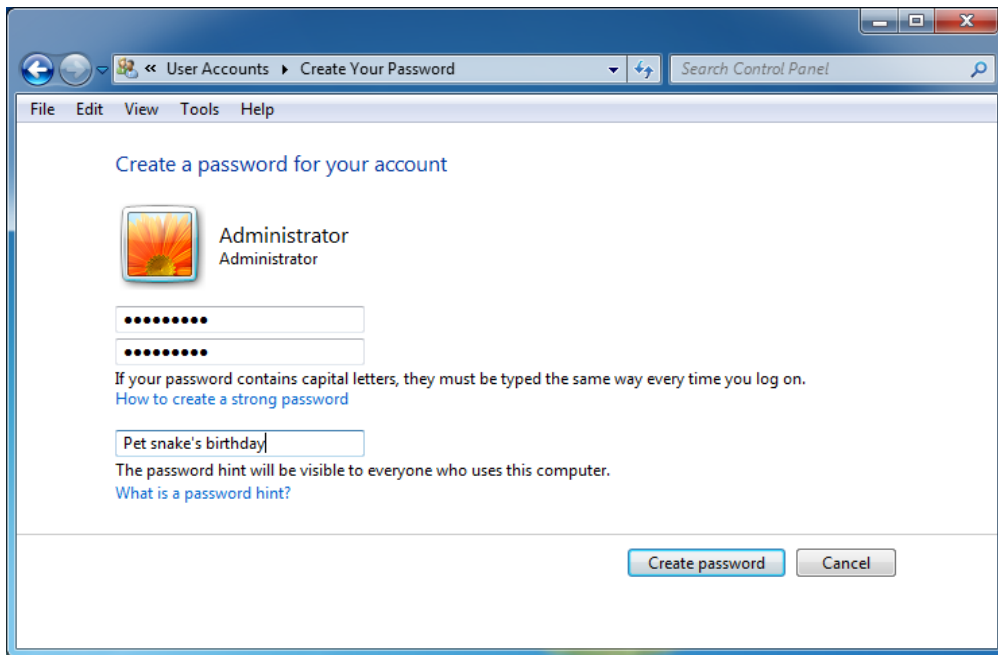
3. Select **Create your Windows password**.



4. Select **Create a password for your account**.

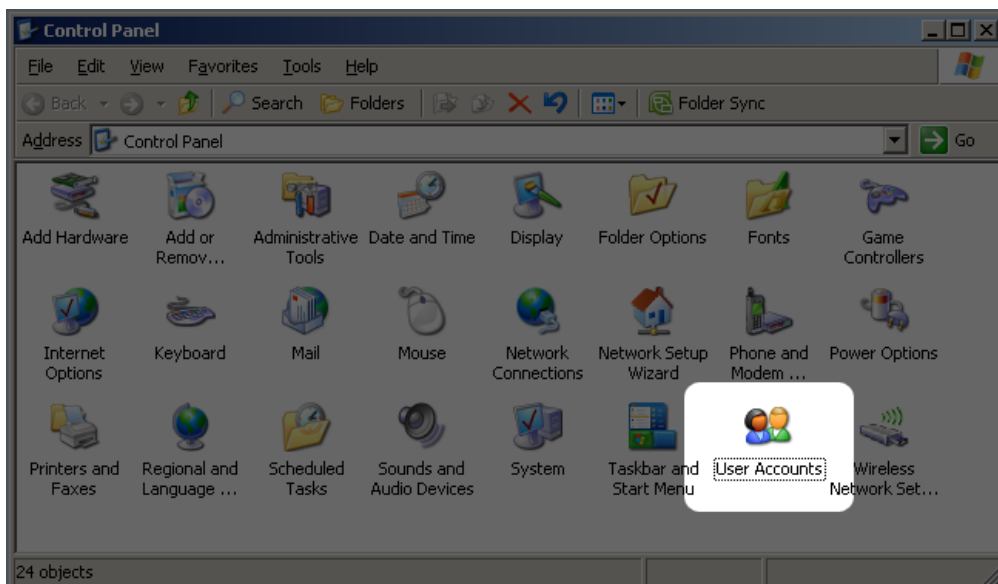


5. Type in your new password, confirm, type a hint to help you remember it, then click **Create password**.

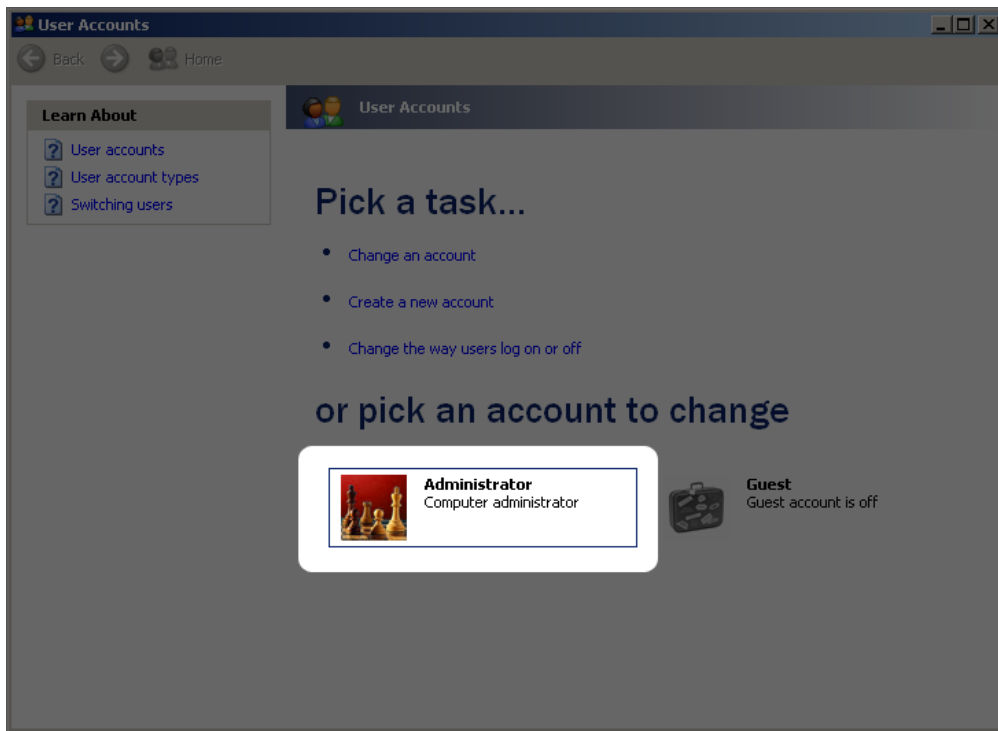


WINDOWS XP USERS

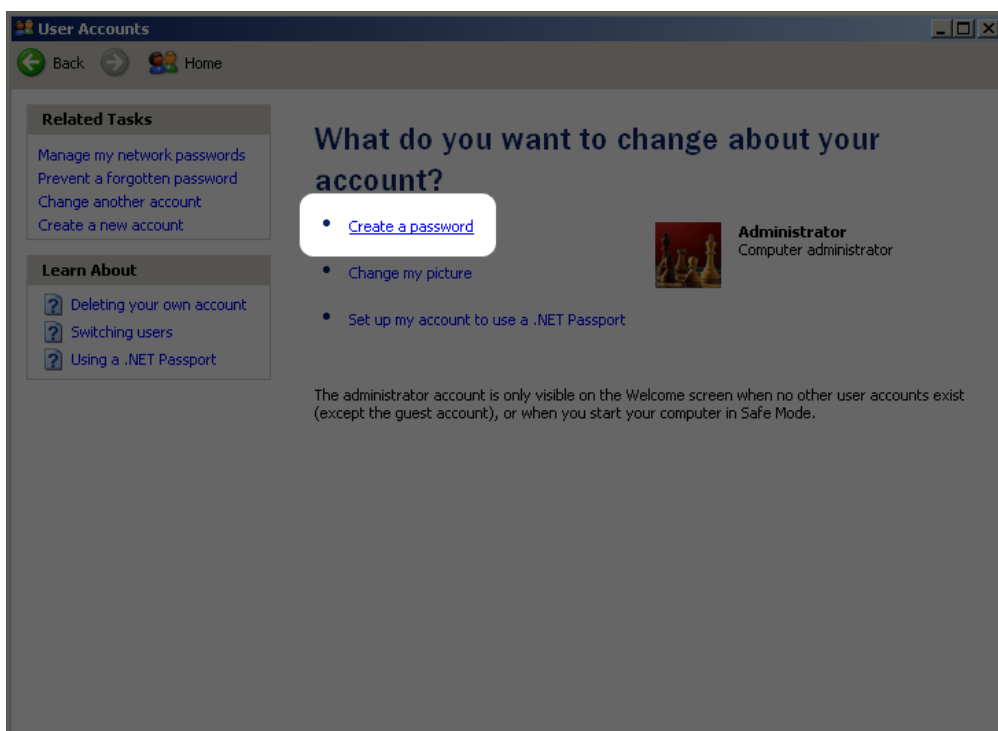
1. Navigate to **Start > Settings Control Panel**.
