MOUNTING THE LA-PRIVATE VOLUME

LA-PRIVATE may be locked to protect data from being accessed by unauthorized users. Follow the steps below to unlock and mount the LA-PRIVATE volume.

Important info: You must create LA-PRIVATE before attempting to mount the volume.

- 1. Connect the LaCie storage device to a compatible interface port on your computer.
- 2. Click twice on the LACIE icon in My Computer/Computer (Windows) or on the desktop (Mac).
- 3. Click twice on the **LaCie Private-Public** application.
- LaCie Private-Public will recognize that you have created a LA-PRIVATE volume. (If you have not created LA-PRIVATE, the application will guide you through the process. See the steps in <u>Create the LA-PRIVATE</u> <u>Volume</u>.) Enter your password in the empty field. Please note that your password is case sensitive.

- 5. To see the characters that you are typing, select the check box for **Display password**. Click **OK**.
