

LOG IN TO LACIE RAID MANAGER

LaCie RAID Manager launches in a web browser that supports Java. It is recommended that you use one of the following browsers:

- Safari
- Firefox

Technical note: LaCie RAID Manager may experience problems with Google Chrome.

Check the settings in Safari to confirm that Safari or Firefox is selected as the default browser:

1. Launch Safari.
2. Go to **Safari > Preferences > General**.
3. Choose the **Default web browser** pull-down menu to select **Safari** or **Firefox**.

BROWSERS AND JAVA

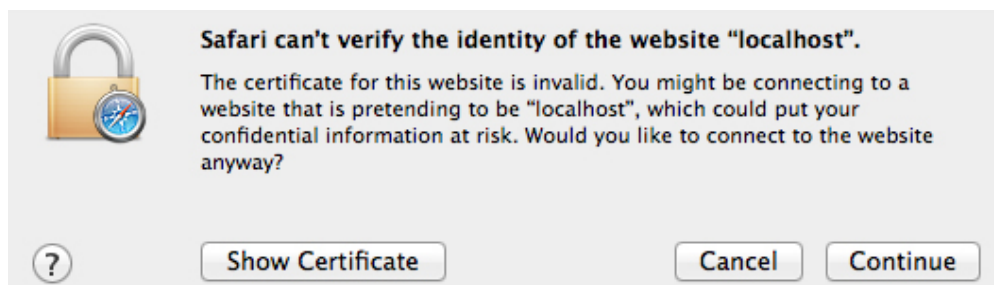
Confirm that Java is enabled in the browser.

- **Safari:** Go to **Safari > Preferences > Security** and check the box next to **Enable JavaScript**.
- **Firefox:** Go to **Tools > Add-ons > Plugins**. Click on the **Java Applet Plug-in** to turn Java on.

LAUNCH LACIE RAID MANAGER

Once it is installed, you can launch LaCie RAID Manager at **Finder > Go > Applications > LaCie RAID Manager**.

SAFARI AND LOCALHOST MESSAGE

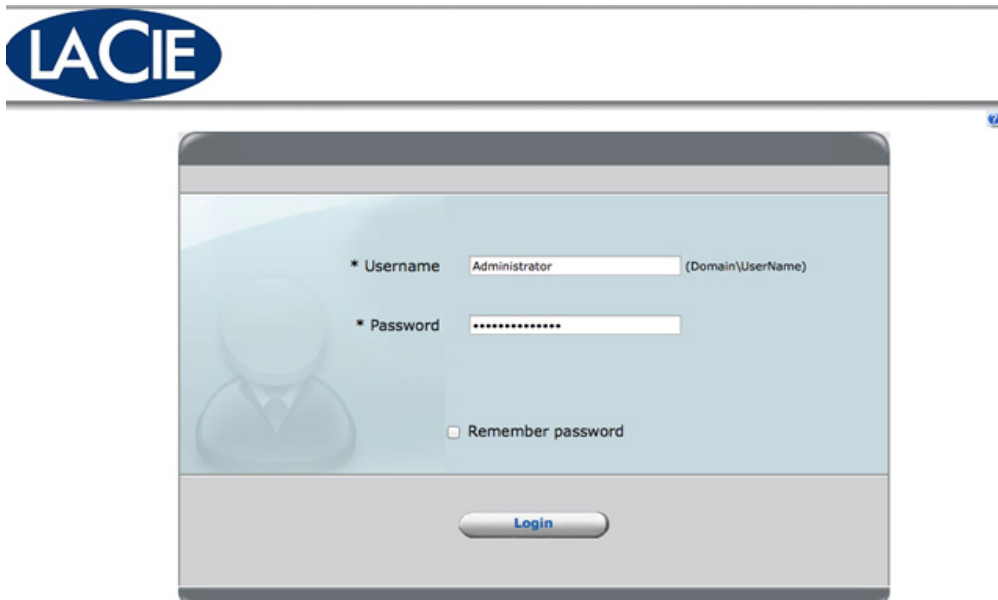


Upon first launching LaCie RAID Manager, Safari users may see a message that reads *Safari can't verify the website "localhost"*. Choose **Continue** to access the login page.

LOGIN PAGE

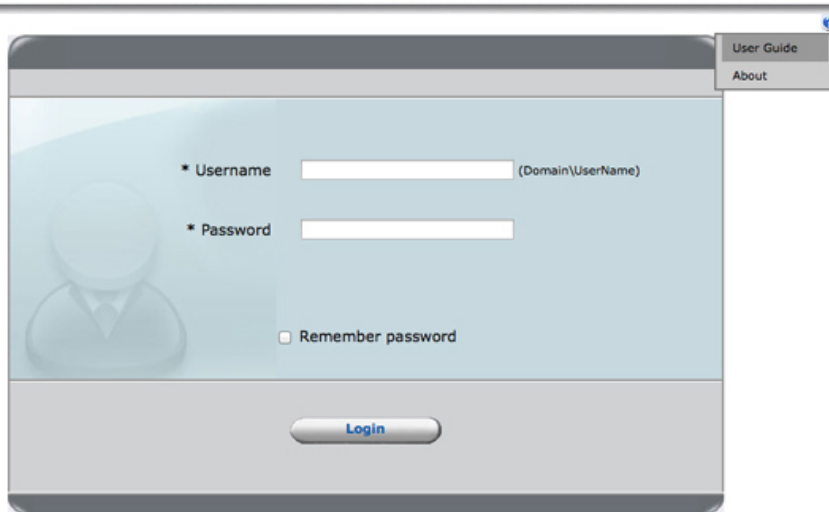


1. Enter a username and password with administration rights to the computer you are using. See the example below.
