

TECHNICAL BRIEF: WUALA

This Technical Brief is a valuable resource to learn how to integrate Wuala secure online storage with your LaCie professional server. The instructions that follow will help you add cloud storage to your data workflow.

Note: While the examples and screenshots come from Windows® Storage Server 2008 R2 Essentials, they apply to Windows Home Server 2011 as well.

ADMINISTRATOR

In order to review, confirm, or redefine the software settings on your LaCie professional server, you must have Administrative rights to the device.

WUALA SECURE ONLINE STORAGE AND YOUR LACIE PROFESSIONAL SERVER

Wuala by LaCie is cloud storage that encrypts all data before being uploaded. Thanks to Wuala's high level of password-protected encryption, you can rest assured that all data stored on your private account is secure. Once Wuala is enabled on your LaCie professional server, you can use your cloud storage as offsite backup for your important files. Wuala also includes features that will enhance your data workflow by adding new layers of data protection and sharing. For example, you can access files using any computer with a connection to the Internet as well as mobile devices running iOS® and Android®.
